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### **Los Altos Community Foundation Announces Fiscal Sponsorship of Appetite for Good**

**Los Altos, CA, February 26, 2021** – Los Altos Community Foundation (LACF) is pleased to announce its fiscal sponsorship of Mountain View, CA-based, Appetite for Good. Founded by longtime Mountain View resident, IdaRose Sylvester, Appetite for Good was created to feed local families and support struggling local restaurants during the COVID-19 pandemic and beyond. Through LACF’s fiscal sponsorship approach, emerging nonprofits such as Appetite for Good can establish their projects and services while LACF manages the administrative burden of operating as a nonprofit.

“LACF believes that a strong local nonprofit ecosystem requires the support of emerging organizations that address critical needs such as food insecurity in our community,” said Adin Miller, LACF’s executive director. “We’re proud of our fiscal sponsorship of Appetite for Good and look forward to helping it grow its capacity and ability to address local service gaps.”

Appetite for Good allows people to purchase online meal vouchers from local restaurants to feed families through local nonprofit partners like the Community Services Agency (CSA) in Mountain View. In its most recent campaign, it partnered with Chef Chu’s in Los Altos for a Lunar New Year’s fundraiser to support Asian families served by CSA. Since its inception, Appetite for Good has fed over 1,600 local residents impacted by food insecurity.

“Appetite for Good is honored to be fiscally sponsored by LACF, “ said Sylvester. “I founded my organization to respond to urgent and rapidly changing needs in our community, and their support means I have more resources, which allows me to focus on my mission. LACF’s support also makes my donor’s, and my nonprofit and restaurant partner’s, experience much more streamlined,” she added.

In addition to Appetite for Good, LACF sponsors and incubates a number of emerging nonprofits. With fiscal sponsorship, social entrepreneurs and community leaders can test and develop a concept to address a local service gap while utilizing LACF’s 501(c)3 tax-exempt status, front and back-office financial capabilities, marketing, and other services. A few other projects that LACF fiscally sponsors include GreenTown Los Altos, MVLA Scholars, and Soil&Water Garden.
